## A shot of déjà vu for Ben and his baby

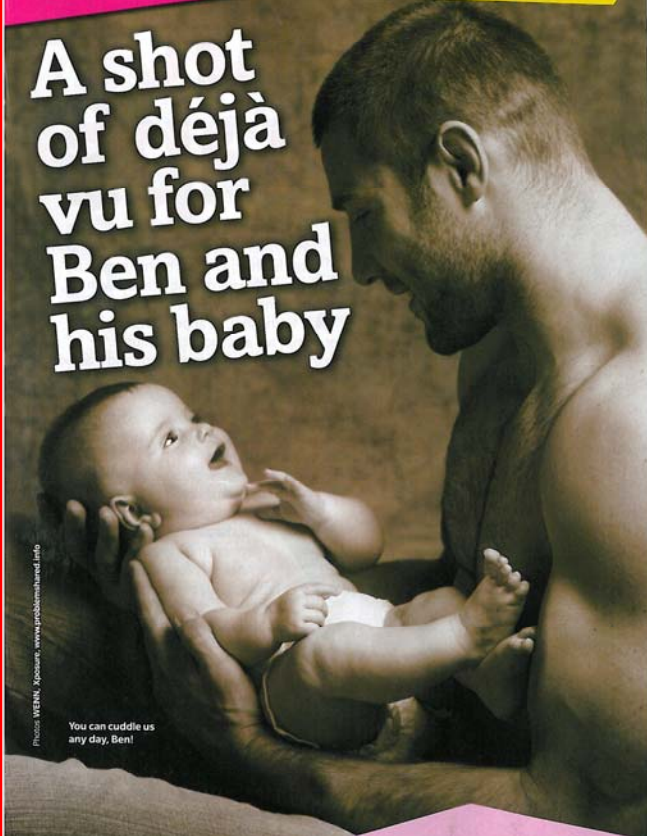
